# Basic Skills SLO Project – Spring 2011 Measuring Our Students' Use of English Beyond the Classroom (Lifelong Learners)

## I. Project:

- Students in level classes only will write a short composition on a given prompt.
- The prompt will be the same for Week 3 and Week 14.

#### Prompt: Explain how you use English outside of the classroom

- Teachers are free to administer the evaluation any time during Week 3 and Week 14.
- This evaluation may also be used for the first and third writing samples in level classes.
- Please present this evaluation to your students as you would any other writing sample in your class (ie: pre-writing brainstorming, questions, discussion).

## II. Procedures:

#### Levels 1 to 6

- All evaluation forms will be provided to you in an envelope and placed in your mailboxes.
- After all students in your class have finished the evaluation, please make copies (front and back) of each evaluation BEFORE you mark on it. We need clean, unmarked copies. TAs are available to assist with this.
- Place all copies back in the envelope and return to the ISO (you may keep originals for your writing samples).
- Follow these same procedures for the post evaluation during Week 14.
