## Continuing Education ESL Department

VESL Career Paths is a two-semester program designed to prepare advanced ESL students who have <u>completed Level 5 or Level 6</u> for academic and career success.

#### **VESL** is for students who:

- ▶ Need more language and work skills for better job opportunities
- Want a college degree but need to improve English and study skills before they transfer to credit
- ► Have a college degree and work experience from native country but need to improve their English so they can earn a vocational certificate or pass a board exam
- Need more English and computer skills in order to be more active in their family's life and in their community

#### Students who complete the VESL program:

- Increase English proficiency
- Gain experience using computers
- ▶ Learn how to design and give media presentations
- Develop job search and interviewing skills
- Earn certificates in keyboarding
- Earn credit-by-exam in the computer courses
- ► Earn a certificate of completion for VESL
